

Now Registered: Chateau® Herbicide for Grape

Chateau Herbicide, with the active ingredient flumioxazin, is a pre-emergent herbicide for use in grapes as well as highbush blueberries, strawberries, asparagus, potatoes, dry bulb onions and tree fruit.

Chateau Herbicide provides residual control of labeled broadleaf weeds including red root pigweed, green pigweed, common ragweed, dandelion, eastern black nightshade and hairy nightshade.

- **Long lasting:** *Chateau* is a pre-emergence herbicide with residual control.
- **Controls tough weeds:** Several weed species are controlled including pigweeds.
- **Farm friendly:** *Chateau* does not leach, does not volatilize.



Application information

- Apply 280 - 420g/ha of *Chateau* as a uniform broadcast spray or as a band directed at the base of the trunk. Avoid contact with foliage or green bark.
- Up to 2 applications per year can be made, at least 30 days apart.
- Apply after final harvest and before bud break for the greatest safety. Do not apply after bud break unless using hooded or shielded application equipment and the applicator can ensure spray drift will not contact crop fruit or foliage.
- *Chateau* can be tank mixed with glyphosate for control of emerged weeds.
- Moisture is needed to activate *Chateau* in the soil for residual weed control.
- Do not apply within 100 metres of non-dormant pears.
