*Chateau* Herbicide, with the active ingredient flumioxazin, is a new herbicide for use in asparagus, dry bulb onions, tree fruit as well as highbush blueberries, strawberries, potatoes, and grapes.

*Chateau* Herbicide provides residual control of labeled broadleaf weeds and grass including pigweeds, lamb's-quarters, common ragweed, dandelion, eastern black nightshade, and hairy nightshade.

- **Long lasting:** *Chateau* is a pre-emergence herbicide with excellent residual control.
- **Controls tough weeds:** Several weed species are controlled including pigweeds.
- **Farm friendly:** *Chateau* does not leach, does not volatilize.

## Application information

- Rate: 280 g/ha (113 g/ac) or 420 g/ha (170 g/ac) depending on soil conditions.
- Apply at least 14 days before spear emergence.
- Apply only to dormant asparagus established for at least one year.
- Use an appropriate water volume to ensure thorough coverage .
- *Chateau* Herbicide may cause injury if spears emerge before the application has been activated with water. Ensure an irrigation (of at least ½ cm) or rain event occurs between application and spear emergence.
- Do not apply by air. Apply once per year; **refer to label for further details.**
