Foray 48BA is a widely used Btk insecticide for fruits and greenhouse vegetables. This liquid formulation is convenient and ready to use. After many years of use, Foray has proven itself as an effective, trusted product. And because Foray 48BA has a unique mode of action, it's an excellent tool for managing resistant insects. It can be used in tank-mix situations to improve the performance of a traditional insecticide or as a rotation partner in conjunction with a traditional insecticide program. In addition, Foray 48BA can be used as part of an effective, all-biological product rotation.

Foray 48BA Advantages

- ◆ Foray 48BA controls leafrollers on apples, pears and raspberries and provides for cabbage looper control on greenhouse peppers, lettuce, cucumbers, and tomatoes.
- ◆ Proven worm control from a leading *Bacillus thuringiensis* (Bt) insecticide.
- ◆ Superior, high potency formulation that is easy to use.
- ◆ The most balanced blend of five bacterial protein toxins for effective, broad-spectrum worm control.
- ◆ Excellent dispersion and mixing characteristics.

Foray 48BA Use Directions & Mode of Action

- ◆ Apply Foray 48BA when larvae are young (early instars), before crop damage occurs.
- ◆ Foray 48BA should be applied when larvae are actively feeding.
- ◆ Thorough spray coverage is essential to provide a uniform deposit at the site of larval feeding since the larvae must consume Foray 48BA for control to occur.
- ◆ After ingesting a lethal dose of Foray 48BA the pest will stop feeding immediately and die within 1-3 days.
